IN THE MATTER OF SURRENDER OF A PORTION OF CLEVELAND STREET (COUNTY ROAD NUMBER 1956) TO THE CITY OF COTTAGE GROVE (21-03-04)

**WHEREAS,** the Board of Commissioners approved Order Number 18-02-13-05 setting March 20, 2018 at 1:30 p.m. to conduct a Public Hearing on the matter of the surrender and transfer of jurisdiction of a portion of Cleveland Street, as described in Exhibit "A", to the City of Cottage Grove; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Cottage Grove, by Resolution No. 1949 dated January 22, 2018, marked as Exhibit "B", which is attached and made a part of this Order, formally requested jurisdiction over the portion of the above mentioned Cleveland Street (County Road No. 1956) be transferred to the City of Cottage Grove; and

**WHEREAS,** the portion of Cleveland Street herein proposed for surrender extends from the westerly right of way of S. 6th Street, thence westerly approximately 0.25 miles as described in Exhibit "A"; and

**WHEREAS**, the portion of Cleveland Street proposed for surrender, lies entirely within the city limits of Cottage Grove; and

WHEREAS, this section of road was annexed into the City of Cottage Grove by Final Order EC CG 08-23, dated March 25, 2008; and

WHEREAS, this transfer comes as the final action of an agreement between Lane County and the City of Cottage Grove as part of the City's consideration for the purchase of land formerly owned by Lane County, identified as Tax Lot 602 on Assessor's Map 20-03-32. The Board of County Commissioners approved this sale on January 30, 2018, pursuant to Order No. 18-01-30-06; and

WHEREAS, ORS 373.270 provides for the surrender and transfer of jurisdiction over county roads within a city, the county may transfer jurisdiction over county roads or parts thereof within a city when it is considered to be necessary, expedient, or in the best interest of the county to do so; and the governing body of the city deems it necessary or expedient and in the best interest of the city to acquire jurisdiction over the county roads or portions thereof and to the same extent as it has over public streets and alleys of the city; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Director of Lane County has recommended this road be surrendered, as stated in the Director's Final Report, marked as Exhibit "C" which is attached hereto and made a part hereof by this Order; and

**WHEREAS,** all legal notice has been provided regarding this matter as required by law as witnessed by an Affidavit of Posting by the Lane County Surveyor, marked as Exhibit "D", attached and made a part of this Order; and

#### NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of Lane County ORDERS as follows:

- 1. Lane County, in accordance with ORS 373.270, hereby surrenders jurisdiction of the portion of Cleveland Street (County Road Number 1956), as described in Exhibit "A" and shown on Exhibit "E", to the City of Cottage Grove;
- This Order to be filed with the Lane County Clerk in the Commissioner's Journal of Administration and copies forwarded to the Lane County Surveyor and Department of Public Works for updating appropriate indexes and County Road records.

The City of Cottage Grove has adopted Resolution No. 1949, dated January 22, 2018, formally requesting the transfer of jurisdiction of a portion of Cleveland Street (County Road No. 1956) within their city limits.

By previous action, the Board of County Commissioners approved Order No. 18-02-13-05 setting a Public Hearing date of March 20, 2018.

This transfer comes as the final action of an agreement between Lane County and the City of Cottage Grove as part of the City's consideration for the purchase of land formerly owned by Lane County, identified as Tax Lot 602 on Assessor's Map 20-03-32. The Board of County Commissioners approved this sale on January 30, 2018, pursuant to Order No. 18-01-30-06.

ORS 373.270 provides for the transfer of jurisdiction over county roads within a city. The county may transfer jurisdiction over county roads or portions thereof within a city when it is considered to be necessary, expedient, or in the best interest of the county to do so; and the governing body of the city deems it necessary or expedient and for the best interest of the city to acquire jurisdiction over the county roads, or portions thereof, to the same extent as it has over public streets and alleys of the city.

Legal notice for the Public Hearing to consider the matter of the surrender of the described portion of Cleveland Street has been provided as required by ORS 373.270.

The surrender of this portion of Cleveland Street will enable the City to maintain, develop, and improve the road to the City's own specifications, standards, and timetables. It is therefore recommended the portion of Cleveland Street (County Road Number1956) described in Exhibit "A" of the Order, be surrendered to the City of Cottage Grove as it will be in the best interest of the County.
