## BEFORE THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LANE COUNTY, OREGON

ORDER NO: 18-06-12-14

In the matter of revising the 2017-2019 Community Corrections Grant-in-Aid and Justice Reinvestment Grant Program (JRGP) budgets and delegating authority to the Public Safety Coordinating Council Criminal Justice Planner to sign and submit JRGP revision forms online and to complete and submit the Community Corrections Biennial Plan Modification form, and to the County Administrator to amend intergovernmental agreements and contracts.

WHEREAS, Lane County was allocated Grant-in-aid funds by Oregon Department of Corrections (DOC) for community corrections programs and Justice Reinvestment Grant Program (JRGP) fund by Oregon Criminal Justice Commission (CJC) to help reduce the prison population, reduce recidivism, increase public safety, and increase offender accountability; and

WHEREAS, Lane County submitted a Community Corrections Plan to DOC and a JRGP application to CJC for these funds, which were subsequently awarded; and

WHEREAS, the Community Corrections Plan and JRGP application both were developed by the Lane County Public Safety Coordinating Council (PSCC); and

WHEREAS, given that the PSCC delegates authority to the PSCC Budget Committee in between meetings of the full PSCC to make recommendations directly to the Lane County Board of Commissioners on revisions to budgets; and

WHEREAS, the PSCC Budget Committee has reviewed expenditures to date and determined some programs are not spending funds as initially projected; and

WHEREAS, other programs are in need of these funds to best meet the state and local goals and achieve target outcomes; and

WHEREAS, the Public Safety Coordinating Council Budget Committee recommended revising both the 2017-2019 Community Corrections Plan and JRGP budget to maximize use of the funds for this biennium; and

WHEREAS, Lane Manual Chapter 21 sets forth policy regarding award of contracts for services and policy regarding signatory authority of the County Administrator;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Board of County Commissioners of Lane County **ORDERS** as follows:

1. Accept and approve the revised 2017-2019 Grant-in-aid Community Corrections

and JRGP budgets.

- 2. Delegate authority to the Public Safety Coordinating Council Chair staff to submit any documents required to revise the budgets as approved by the Board.
- 3. Delegate authority to the County Administrator to execute amendments to intergovernmental agreements and contracts to reflect the 2017-2019 budget revisions below. Abbreviations are: Parole & Probation (P&P) and Lane Council of Governments (LCOG).
