POLICY: It is the policy of this Sheriff's Office to provide deputies to support special law enforcement services to the Oregon Dunes National Recreation Areas within Lane County.

RULE: None

PROCEDURES:

I. Duties of Deputies Assigned to Dunes Patrol:

- A. Deputies assigned to dunes patrol, either continual or temporary, shall have the responsibility to:
 - 1. Fulfill general law enforcement duties.
 - 2. Assist federal and state law enforcement with their duties.
 - 3. Investigate complaints of unlawful operation of O.H.V's on federal and state lands.
 - 4. Perform vehicle identification checks on O.H.V.'s when possible to combat use of stolen vehicles on public lands.
 - 5. Assist emergency medical responders in locating injured persons in the O.D.N.R.A.
 - 6. Enforce state and federal laws and regulations regarding maximum sound decibels and spark arresting mufflers.
 - 7. Promote safe O.H.V. operation on public lands through public education.

- 8. Perform routine maintenance on equipment assigned to the program and ensure all equipment is maintained in good working condition by adhering to established preventative maintenance schedules.
- 9. Enforce all applicable provisions of county, state, and federal laws pertaining to O.H.V. operations.

II. <u>Duties of Sergeant Assigned to Dunes Patrol:</u>

- A. Supervise deputies assigned to dunes patrol and maintain current scheduling of Deputy shifts, to include time off, training, etc.
- B. Act as the liaison for O.H.V. Committee/county administrative issues, coordinating the Sheriff's Office response to address needs identified by the O.H.V. Committee staff and the Sheriff's Office.
- C. Prepare the annual contract for dunes law enforcement services in coordination with the O.H.V. Committee Board and the Sheriff's Office fiscal section. The dunes Sergeant will present prepared contracts for approval by the Sheriff's Office and O.H.V. Committee.
- D. Ensure the program is operating within the terms of the contract and assigned personnel are adhering to the provisions of the O.H.V. contract.
